3. **Financial Report** (Doug Anderson)

Approximately \$2000 in our regular account and approximately \$4000 in the scholarship account.

4. **Trophy Report** (Doug Anderson/Kevin Moore)

5. **Membership Report** (Geoff McElgunn)

To date, 34 member schools have paid their 2007 membership fees. A list of the paid member schools is available online at the BCSSMA website.

6. **Ashcroft Update** (Kevin Moore)

Last weeks race was a very well organized event!!! Six high school class cars were in attendance along with 15-18 juniors dragsters.

7. **2007 Scholarships** (Doug Anderson)

8. **"L" Driver Orientation** (Cory Wong/Kevin Moore)

The April 19 driver orientation for "L" drivers was a roaring success. In total, 17 students participated with half of them obtaining their 12 required runs that night.

Feedback from those teachers in attendance suggests that 12 required runs may be too many and that 10 may be a better number to consider. It was also suggested that once an "L" driver has obtained their 12 runs, then they should be limited to 14 second runs until such time that they have obtained their "N". Both of these items will be discussed further at the AGM.
